Patient: Mia Torres, MB-214 — 6 hr post vaginal delivery

SBAR

S: Patient reports dizziness when standing and says her peripad is soaked again — heavier than right after delivery.

B: G2P2, SVD at 0038, EBL ~450 mL. Pregnancy history significant for PIH (pregnancy-induced hypertension), treated with labetalol in third trimester — discontinued after delivery per order. Oxytocin infusion completed 0445.

A: 0700 vitals BP 108/68, HR 102, RR 18. Fundus boggy at U+2 when not massaged; lochia heavy rubra. Bladder not assessed since 0600 bathroom trip. Patient lightheaded with position change.

R: Immediate bedside FLB assessment. Massage if boggy, call second RN, do not give uterotonics from eMAR until BP and PIH history reviewed with preceptor. Notify provider if bleeding persists after massage.
